Concept mapping is a mindtool (cognitive tool) that can enhance the interdependence of declarative and procedural knowledge to produce yet another form of knowledge representation known as structural knowledge (Jonassen, 1996). Structural knowledge is best described as knowing why something is the case. It helps learners integrate and interrelate declarative and procedural knowledge by activating the perceived static nature of declarative knowledge and by increasing the awareness of why one ...

Concept Mapping as a Mindtool for Critical Thinking ...

Critical thinking involves reasoning, in a manner where a person reflects on his or her own thoughts, actions and knowledge. In nursing, it can be applied when creating a concept map. A concept map is a diagram that shows a patient's problems, nursing interventions that can address the problems and the relationship between the two concepts.

How to Apply Critical Thinking to Concept Map for Nursing ...

Concept mapping is a technique for facilitating validation of one's critical thinking by graphically depicting the structure of complex concepts. Each of our three studies of concept mapping involved approximately 240 students enrolled in four sections of an introductory psychology course.

Impact of a concept map teaching approach on nursing ...

The experimental group was taught to use concept mapping of patient information to prepare for clinical experiences. The control group was taught to use traditional nursing care plans. Critical thinking skills were measured with the California Critical Thinking Skills Test, which yielded six scores: an overall score and five subscales (analysis, evaluation, inference, deductive reasoning, and inductive reasoning).

The pooled effect size showed that, comparing with traditional methods, concept mapping could improve subjects' critical thinking ability measured by California Critical Thinking Disposition Inventory (CCTDI), California Critical Thinking Skill Test (CCTST) and Critical Thinking Scale (CTS).

The effectiveness of concept mapping on development of ...

Critical thinking is a complex cognitive process broadly defined as the use of purposeful, insightful judgment that involves the development and effective utilization of multiple dimensions of cognition to interpret and analyze a situation and arrive at and act on an appropriate conclusion or solution (Facione, 2013).

Impact of a concept map teaching approach on nursing ...

Results showed an increase in analysis of thoughts, feelings, and critical thinking and connections to clinical concepts for students who used concept mapping during the debriefing session. Results suggest the application of concept mapping during debriefing as a useful teaching modality to help make connections to clinical concepts.

Concept mapping is a technique developed by Joseph Novak in the 1970s in which students create a 2-dimensional diagram outlining their understanding of the relationships between and among important concepts within a given subject area. 13 - 15 Unlike most conventional examinations, CMA may provide unique insights into how an individual organizes his or her knowledge or comes to think about a problem.

Introduction To Concept Mapping In Nursing Critical ...

In summary, the positive effect of concept mapping as a critical thinking technique tends to be greatest when concept maps are constructed during preparation for performance on a specific task. Also, the type of map constructed was not found to be differentiating factor.

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
