Overfilling Manual Transmission Fluid

If you overfill your transmission with one liter or more above the max mark, your transmission could be damaged. Transmission fluid performs several functions in your vehicle. It is mainly used for lubrication, but it conditions your seals, controls the temperature of your transmission, and protects metal surfaces and moving parts from wear caused by friction.

Will a Slightly Overfilled Transmission get Damaged ...

Overfilling the transmission fluid will not cause seals to break, but they may leak. The transmission is vented so that pressure won't build in the unpressurized areas. Transmission fluid can leak out these vents if it is too high. The seals higher in the transmission may also leak, but these seals are not pressurized.

What Will Happen If My Transmission Is Overfilled With Fluid?

Overfilling a manual transmission causes the fluid to leak from the vent and the gear trains to slow down when the clutch is depressed, leading to gear shifting problems. When adding transmission fluid, checking the fluid level often can prevent overfilling.
