The hills lie between the Cheyenne and Belle Fourche rivers and rise about 3,000 feet (900 metres) above the surrounding plains. They culminate in Black Elk Peak (7,242 feet [2,207 metres]), the highest point in South Dakota.

The Black Hills are a dome shaped structure, sloping more steeply to the east than from the west with highest elevation of 2,207 m above mean sea level (Froiland 1990). Soils of the Black Hills are identified as the gray wooded soil region, which is unique to South Dakota (Froiland 1990). The Black Hills ecosystem is comprised of four distinct vegetation complexes: 1) Rocky Mountain coniferous forest, 2) Northern coniferous forest, 3) Grassland complex, and 4) Deciduous complex.
